**BILL WOULD REQUIRE INSURANCE
COVERAGE OF LYME DISEASE TREATMENT -**
PA Rep. Matt Baker's

With cases of Lyme disease on the rise, Rep. Matt Baker is authoring legislation that would ensure insurance providers cover available and emerging diagnostics and treatment options for Lyme disease and related tick-borne diseases. The new legislation would require health insurers to cover treatment plans for Lyme disease or related tick-borne illnesses as prescribed by a patient's health care practitioner, regardless if the treatment plan includes short-term or long-term antibiotic treatment.
